September 13th Sunday Rune and Card Reading



Reading no. 1 – Honey Calcite.

Honey Calcite is a stone of leadership. It is said to raise our vibration and enhances our ability to walk the path of the Spiritual Warrior, aligning with truth, honesty and courage.

The energy of this stone helps us to overcome obstacles and aids our recovery from any kind of abusive or toxic situation. Personally, I find this powerful little angel emanates a sense of solidness, durability and resilience, which enables me to remain grounded, particularly during times of accelerated growth and upheaval.

I have always associated Honey Calcite with the Archangel Gabriel. 'Gabriel' in Hebrew literally means 'God is my Strength'. Known as the Archangel of revelation and communication, Archangel Gabriel speaks of the truth and helps us to overcome Fear and rise into the truest and best version of ourselves.

Reading no. 2 – Aragonite.

Aragonite is known as a stone of strength and support. It is said to align with the Earth Goddess, keeping us anchored and grounded, particularly during times of transition and sudden change.

I find this powerful little stone brings me a sense of safety, generating feelings of reliability and consistency, even if the world around me is feeling unsettled.

Reading no. 3 - Selenite.

For me, Selenite is one of the essentials in my Crystal toolkit and a personal favourite. It draws its name came from Selene, the Greek Goddess of the Moon, and just as the Moon gathers light from the Sun and redistributes it across the Earth, so too Selenite literally embodies and radiates light.

This magical and illuminating crystal can be used for healing in its own right, or used with other crystals. I personally keep several Selenite sticks and much as I would put my crystals out overnight to re-charge at the Full Moon, I use my selenite sticks to re-charge the energy of my other crystals.

Associated with the alignment of the third eye, crown and etheric chakras, this powerful crystal is a must for anyone seeking to connect with their Guides and Angels, also known as an Abundance Stone, perhaps a reflection of its generous and giving nature, it is said to raise our awareness and connect us with our higher self.
